Water bottles (Ahead of hot weather)

Please be reassured, in Reception, we focus on 'super hydration' breaks. When the weather is hot children also have access to their class water bottle box at lunchtime.

Staff monitor the bottles mid-morning, after lunch and mid-afternoon and pop a top up in if required, so if your child comes home with a nearly full bottle of water it is due to the fact that we have re-filled not that children haven't been drinking.

Please put plain water in bottles.

Even those children who are not keen on drinking water at home are always happy to drink it in school, as we make our hydration breaks encouraging!

Summer term

Bottles to contain plain water only
