We continue to use Accelerated Reader for children to test of the books they have read. This can be accessed in school (at designated times) or from home.

History - The Anglo-Saxons

Anglo-Saxon Home

Create an Anglo-Saxon house using junk modelling, LEGO, clay or drawing.

A Day in the Life Write a diary entry from the point of view of an Anglo-Saxon child.

Anglo-Saxon Artefact Sketch

Research an Anglo-Saxon artefact (helmet, brooch, sword).

Draw and label it, explaining what it was used for.

Science - Sound

Sound Hunt Go on a sound hunt around your home - take photos of where you found the sounds.

Make a Musical Instrument Create a simple instrument using household items.

Design & Technology - Mechanical Systems (Cars)

Car Designer

Design (and build) a car with moving wheels.

How far does it travel? What could make it go further?

Computing - Coding

Algorithm at Home

Write an algorithm for an everyday task (e.g. brushing teeth, making toast).

Use numbered steps and clear instructions.

Coding Practice

Use Scratch, Purple Mash or Logo.

Create a simple program that involves movement and rotation.

Geography - Where Food Comes From

Farm to Fork

Choose one food (e.g. bread, milk, bananas). Create a flow chart showing its journey from farm to plate.

Food Map

Draw a world map and label where different foods come from.

Seasonal Food Spotter

Look in your fridge or cupboards. Which foods are grown in the UK? Which are imported?

French - Family & Seasons Vocabulary

My Family Tree

Create a simple family tree and label it in French: *mère, père, frère, sœur, grand-mère*

Seasons Poster

Create a poster showing the four seasons in French: *le printemps, l'été, l'automne, l'hiver*
