## Introduction

At the start of the meeting, Mrs Liversidge discussed the role of the school council and how it can affect change in school. Each member communicates issues discussed with their class and can collect ideas from them to share at meetings. Mrs Moore was introduced as the new school council teacher representative.

## Issues discussed:

### 1. Plans for playgrounds

Mrs Liversidge shared the proposed plans with the council for the school playgrounds. The feedback from the councillors was:  
"People can be more imaginative."  
"More activities, less likely to bump heads."  
"Excited!"

### 2. Playground space/equipment

The members discussed other ideas for playground space:  
Box of chalk, sand pit with toys, role-play area, book box, sensory garden, trampoline, maze, nap area, comfy blankets to relax, zen garden, maze.

### 3. Daily Mile

The councillors discussed ideas for how to improve the daily mile by making it more engaging. The responses were:

- \*Running races
- \*Collect points for laps and receive prizes
- \*Teachers to set challenges
- \*Obstacle course using new equipment
